ANNOUNCES THE WINNERS OF ITS
SECOND POETRY COMPETITION
FOR HUDSON VALLEY POETS***

Mohonk Mountain Stage Company (MMSC) announces the winners of its second Poetry Contest, **Vanguard Voices of the Hudson Valley**. The contest was open to all writers living in the Hudson Valley of New York, from Albany to the metro-New York City area. With over two hundred and fifty poems submitted, the First Place (\$200) was awarded to **Christine Lilian Turczyn of Rhinebeck, NY** Second Place (\$100) was awarded to **Mr. Ken Holland of Fishkill, NY** and Third Place (\$75) was awarded to **Ms. Jo Pitkin of Cold Spring, NY**. In addition, four Honorable Mentions were selected. All prize-winning poems, as well as selected other entries, will be published in MMSC's *Vanguard Voices of the Hudson Valley – Poetry 2007*, and will be read in a public performance, **New York Writing**, on Friday, May 4, by the MMSC's Readers Theatre Group at Unison Arts Center in New Paltz.

Judges for the 2007 Vanguard Voices competition were William E. Connors, Dr. Stella Deen, Dr. Barbara Adams and Professor Emeritus O. Howard Winn, with Eamon Grennan, Dexter M. Ferry Jr. Professor of English at Vassar College, serving as the final judge. "All of these poets surely celebrate, and animate, the written word," says Mr. Grennan, "Congratulations to all the winners, and to Mohonk Mountain Stage Company for their encouragement of Hudson Valley voices." In affirming MMSC's decision to begin publishing as an integral part of its programs, MMSC's Producing Director, Robert Miller, noted, "Dedicated to performing the written word, Mohonk Mountain Stage Company believes in celebrating the work of gifted writers past and present, and also in encouraging writers whose work may not yet be recognized by sharing it with our audience. MMSC's Vanguard Voices of the Hudson Valley regional poetry competition is one aspect of this important mission."

Mohonk Mountain Stage Company is an independent theater company that has been operating in the Hudson Valley since 1994. MMSC celebrates ideas, imagination and ingenuity through its award-winning Readers Theatre Group, a literary journal and an annual theatre scholarship award.
